



Information about Sydkatten's International SVERAK (FIFe) show in Malmö April 14 and 15 2012, at Stadionmässan, Stadiಂಗatan 25, Malmö. Two certificates show.

A Russian Blue Special will be arranged by Ryssfolket Saturday April, 14.

General information:

- * FIFe and SVERAK show rules are valid.
- * Veterinary examination and check-in Saturday and Sunday at 6.30-8.00.
- * The cats are shown by the owner.
- * Veterinary examination is obligatory for all cats entering the show hall. Pedigrees, passports and vaccination certificates must be presented. FIFe and SVERAK show rules are valid. Vaccinations required are Feline Parvovirus and Cat Influenza, that must be taken no later than 15 days before the show. Also rabies vaccination is required for cats travelling to Sweden from abroad. For rabies vaccination rules and other travelling rules see

Observe that these rules are valid from January 1, 2012 when the rules for travelling with cats will be changed in Sweden and adapted to the rest of the EU.

- * The show closes for exhibitors at the latest at 19.00 both days.
- * Sydkatten is celebrating 50 years and therefore there will be a theme of the 60's with awards for best cage decoration and best outfit.
- * Everyone must use the cages provided by SVERAK at the show. There is not enough room for bringing your own Sturdi or other cages.

Entry to the show:

The entry time starts January 16 and ends February 8. Don't be late since the show is limited to 580 cats/day. This is a very popular show and will fill up quickly.
